• Adult Education (e.g., basic education, English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL), civics/citizenship class, High School Equivalency (HSE) preparation in English and Spanish, etc.)

• Senior Services (e.g., Meals on Wheels, volunteer program, health and fitness activities, computer and art classes, etc.)

• Mental Health Services (e.g., individual, group and family counseling, children's blended case management, etc.)

• Business Development (e.g., computer classes, business literacy classes, business development resources, commercial corridor revitalization, etc.).
